

Changes to Islip Baby Clinic

Instead, it will be held every other Wednesday (10.30am-12.30pm) in Islip Village Hall (this will be a joint venture with the local Rural Children's Centre).

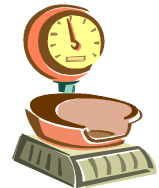
A member of the Health Visiting Team will be available, and you will have the opportunity to stay for a drink and meet other parents.
